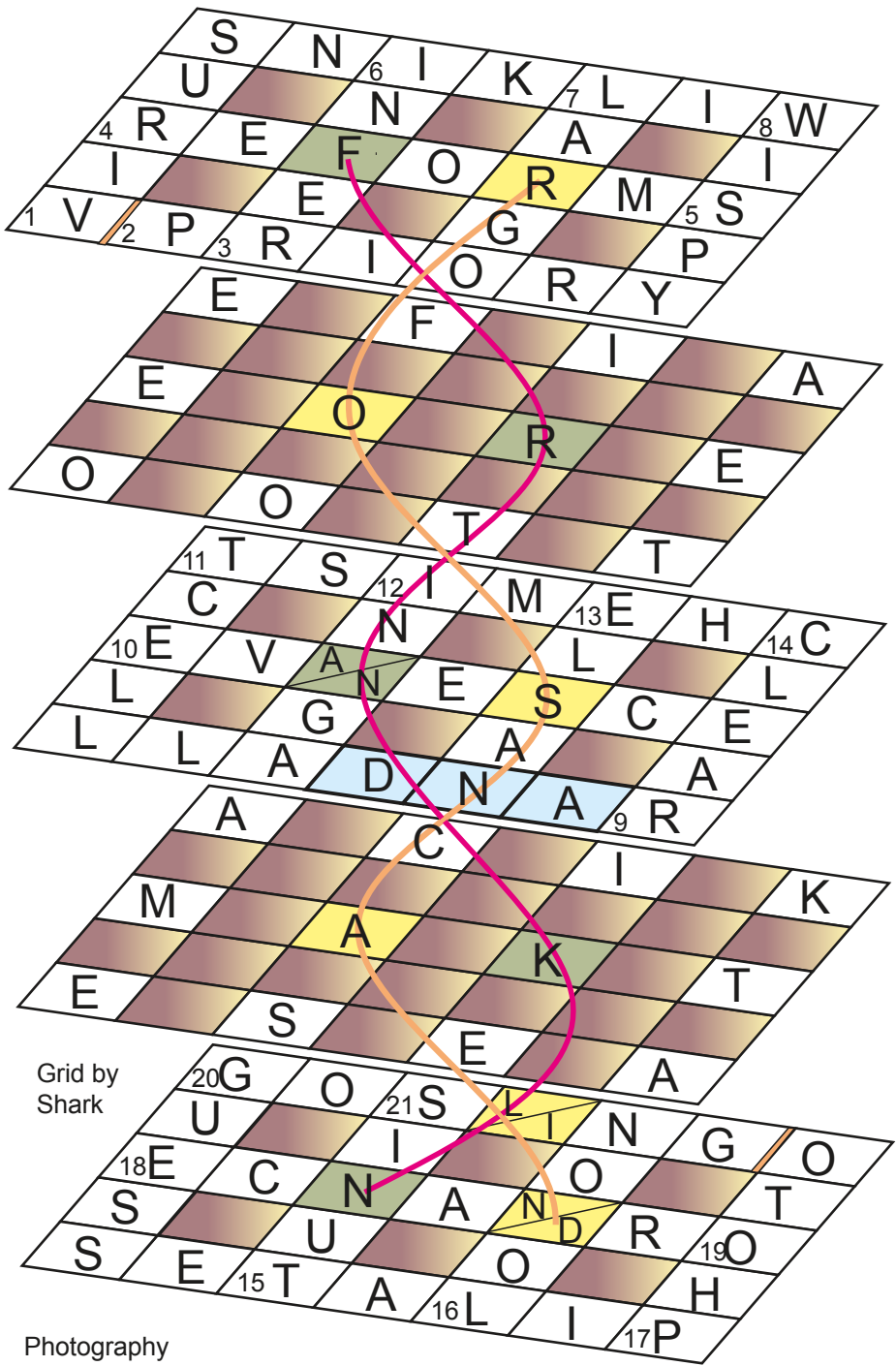




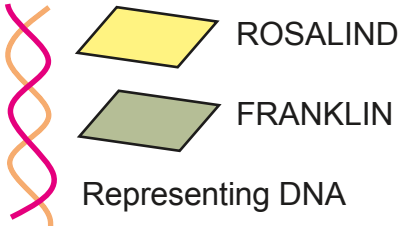

Grid by Shark

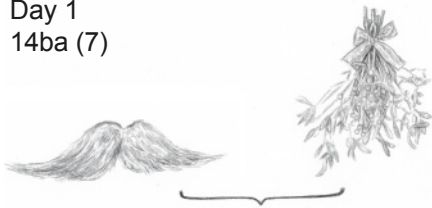

This crossword celebrates the centenary of the birth of CHEMIST ROSALIND FRANKLIN, born 25 July 1920 in LONDON, who first captured the structure of DNA using X-ray crystallography (as illustrated in PHOTO 51). At the time she worked for RANDALL, alongside WILKINS and her student was GOSLING. Whilst alive, she was known for analysing the molecular structure of the VIRUS. She was not given a Nobel prize (unlike WILKINS as they were not awarded posthumously), having previously died of ovarian cancer at the age of 37.

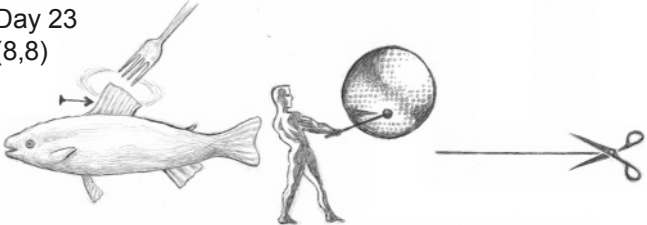
