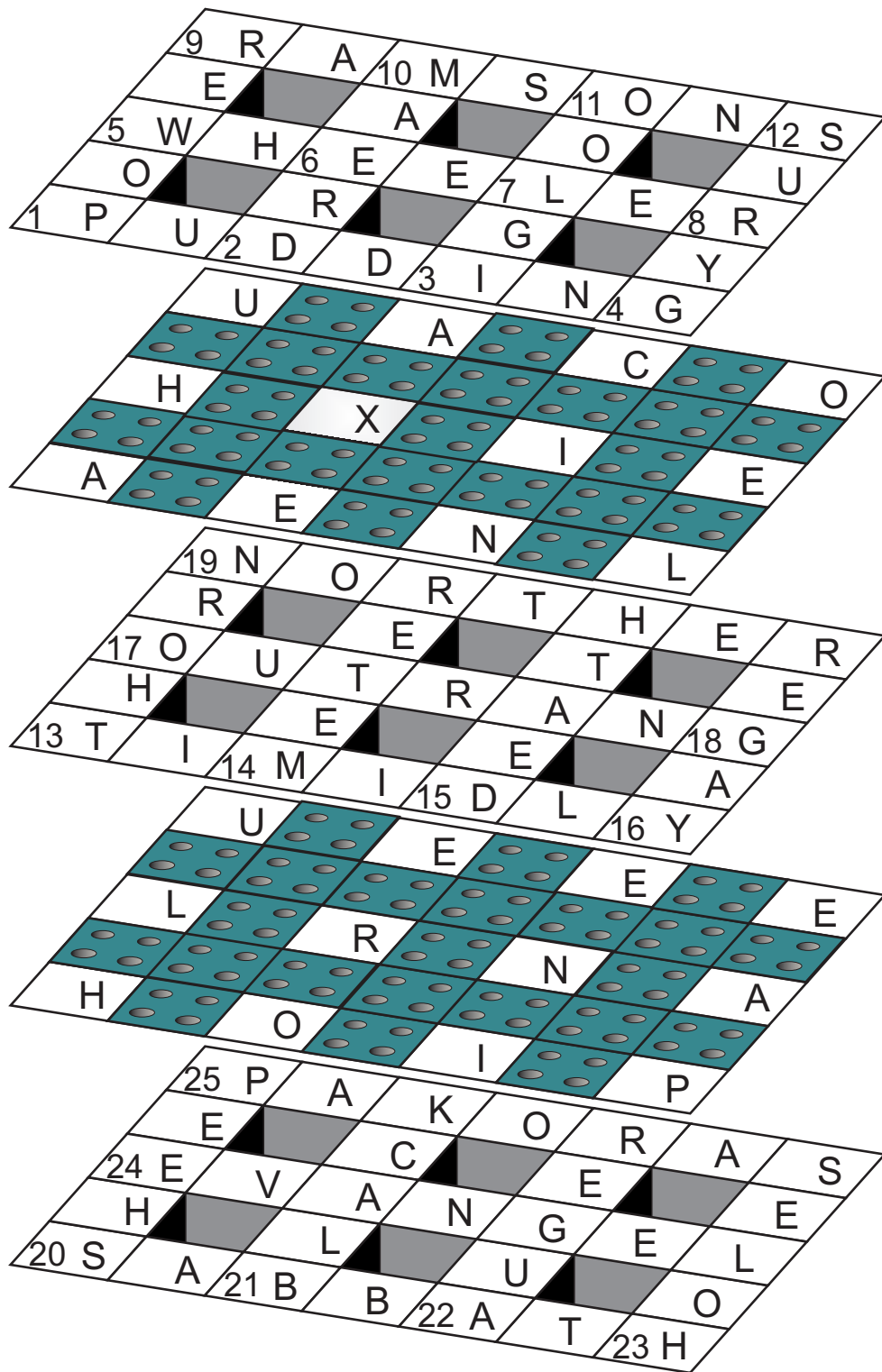


July 2011 Tyrus
