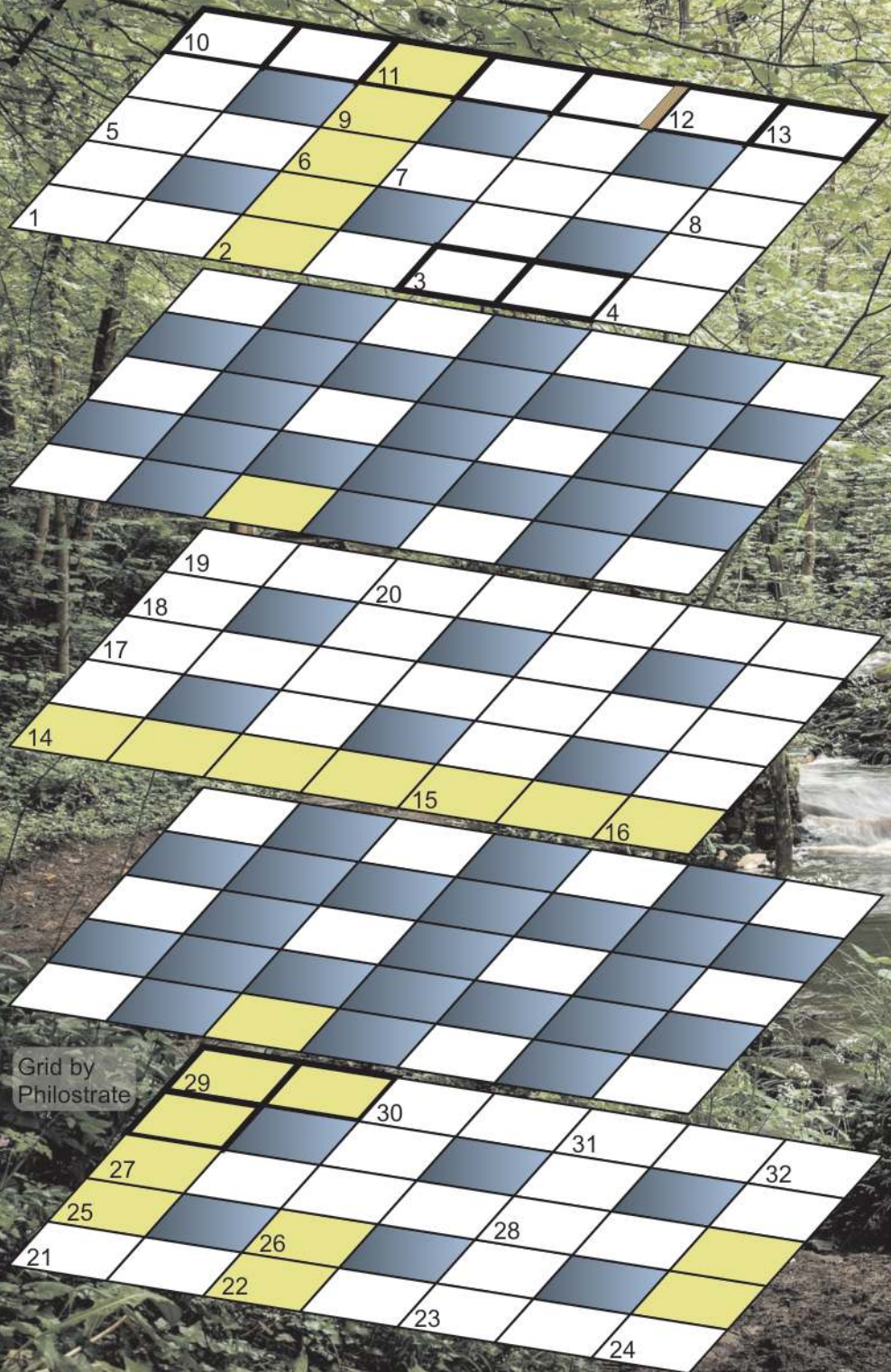


# May 2018 Pasquale Philostrate
