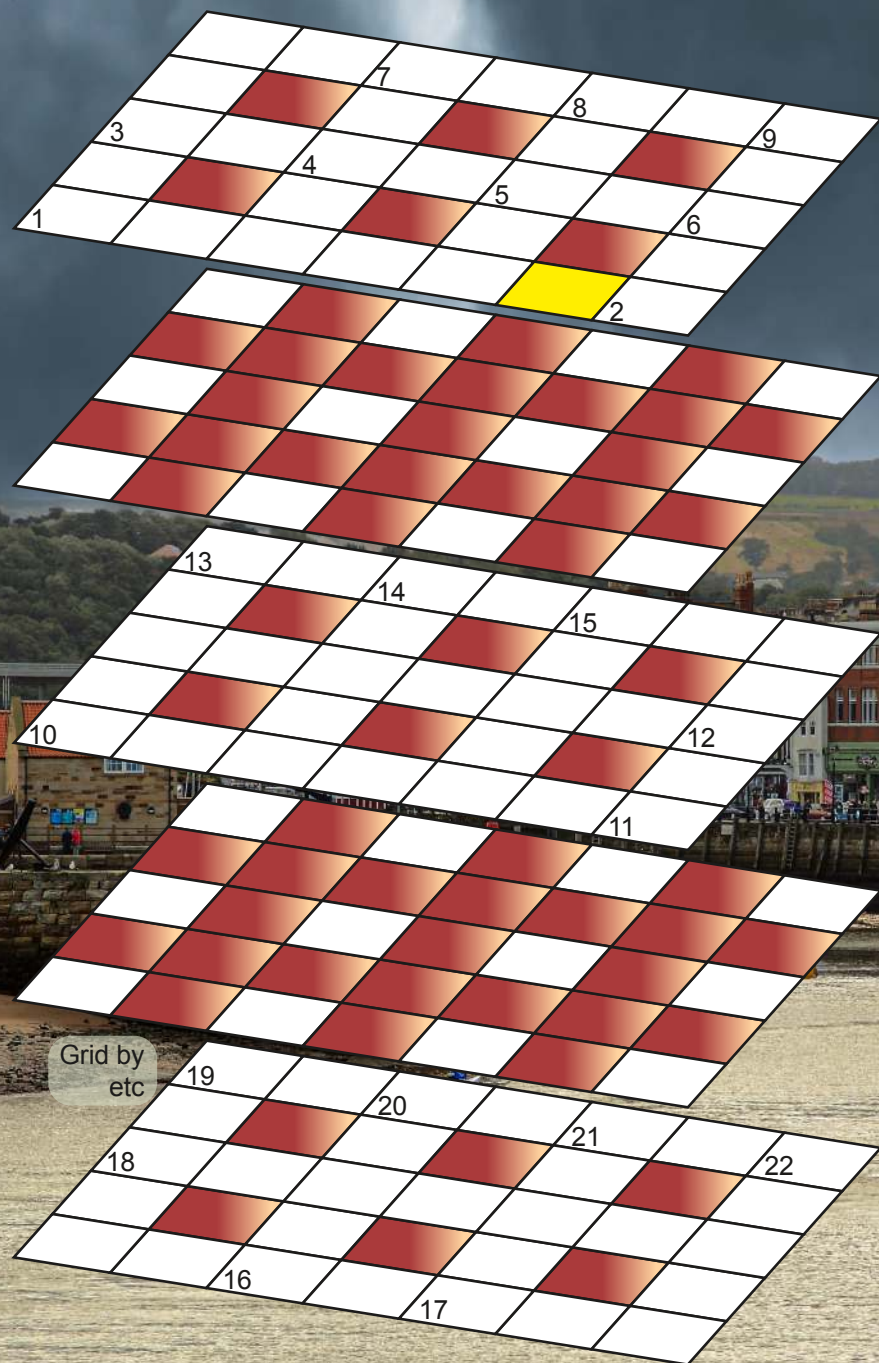


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
Enigmatist etc

This puzzle celebrates the 250th anniversary of an event.

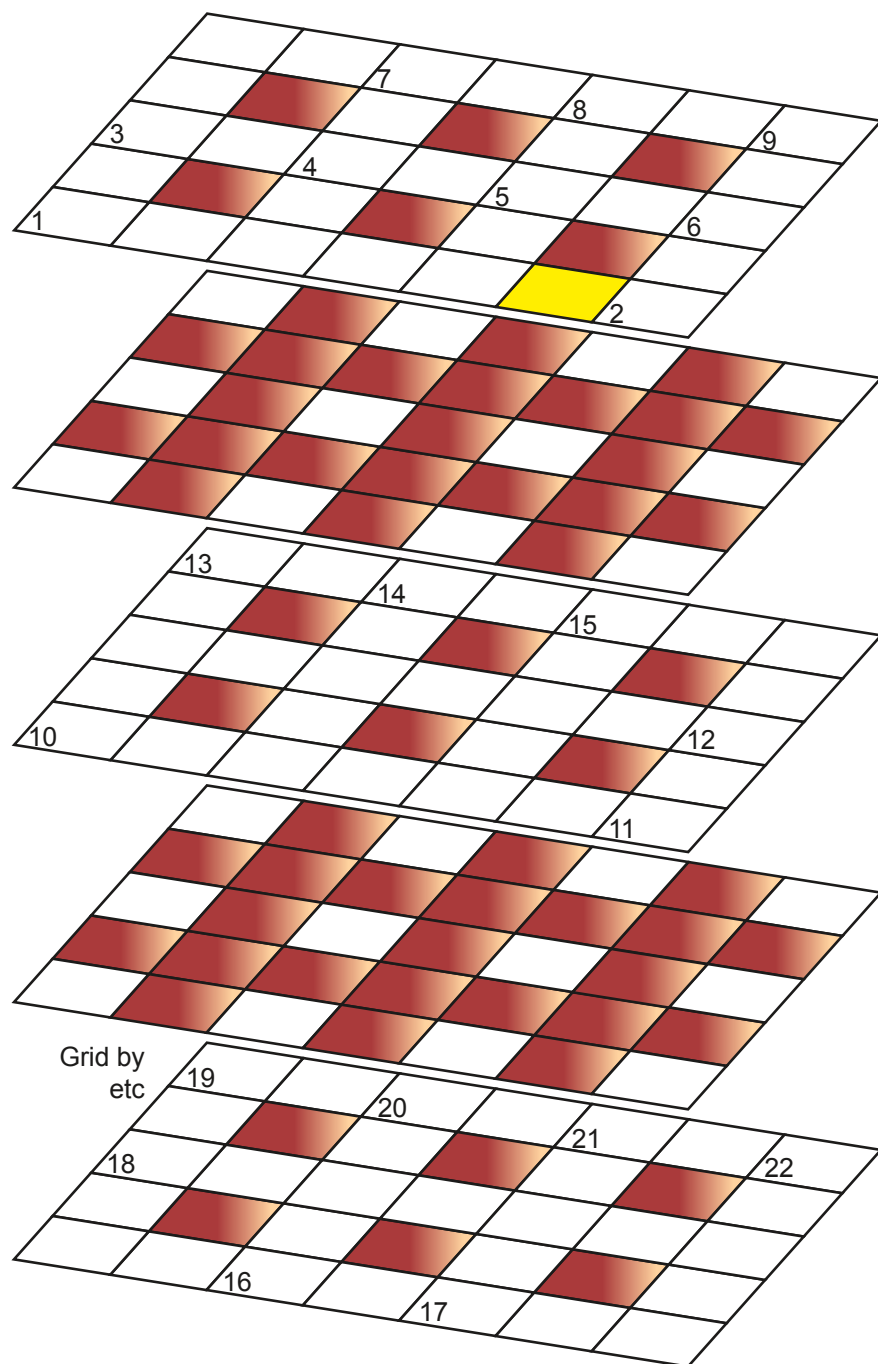

Letter counts are given for the untreated solutions. All treated entries are words. Solvers should submit with their entries the (untreated) name of the event: "Day 4 * ‡" (6,3,5).
