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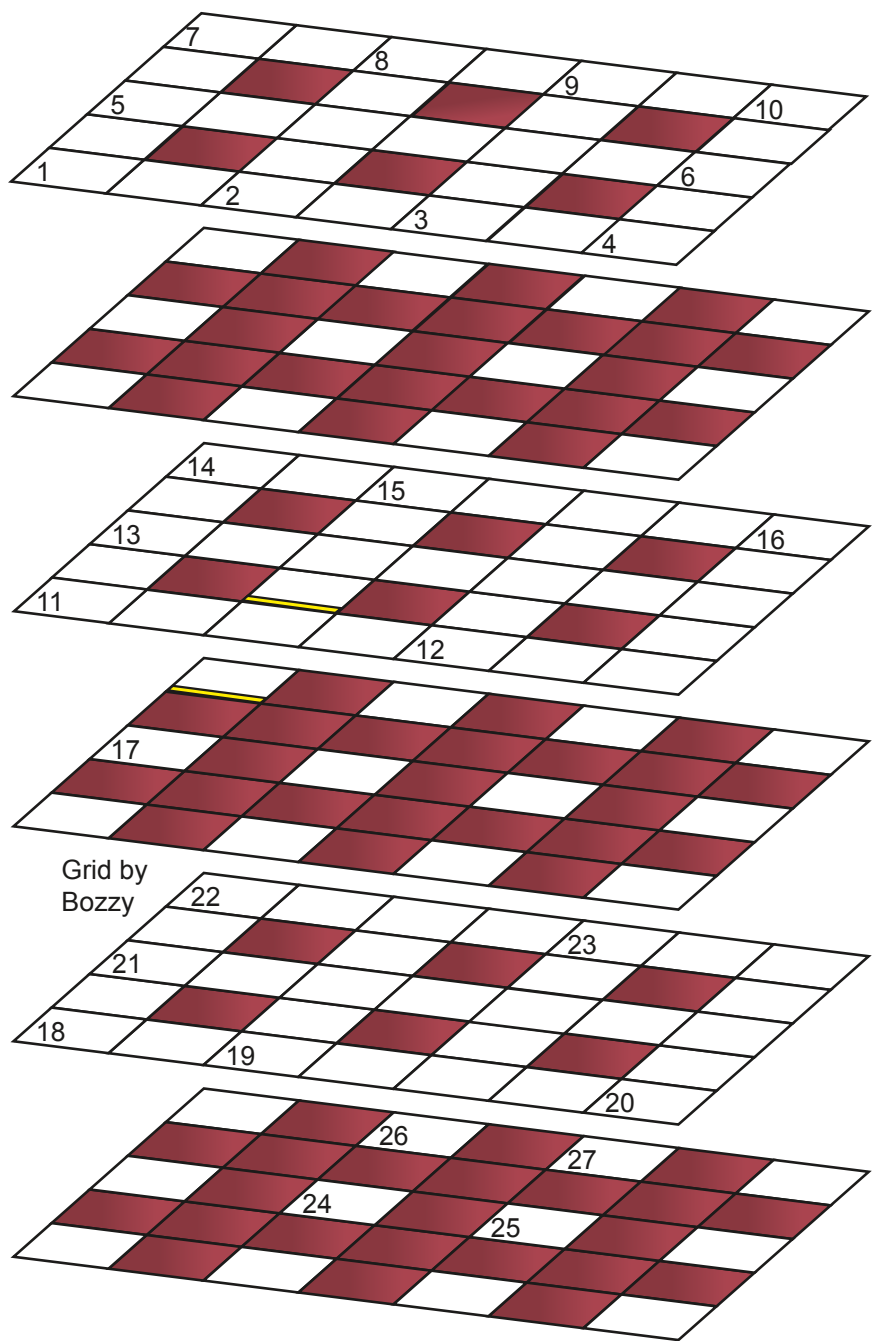


The lights in the 4th level spell out two appropriate names (9 and 3 respectively) hinted at by Day 19, which must be submitted with your entry.
