## June 2024 Shark

Exactly 50 years ago, a term was coined for the first time in 5ac,7to,21ac. This can be found in the entirety of one layer of the crossword and must be submitted with your entry.

You must appropriately change both unclued 24ups in such a way as to come right up to date, representing the full 50 years of this recurrent process. The whole grid represents the content of the shaded cells. When entering the changed items, you must apply its well-known description ( $6,2,3,6$ ) and will then find that while up/down items become non-words, eight new, real words are formed and no blank cells appear in the final grid.

Clues are presented in alphabetical order of their solutions before alteration.*
