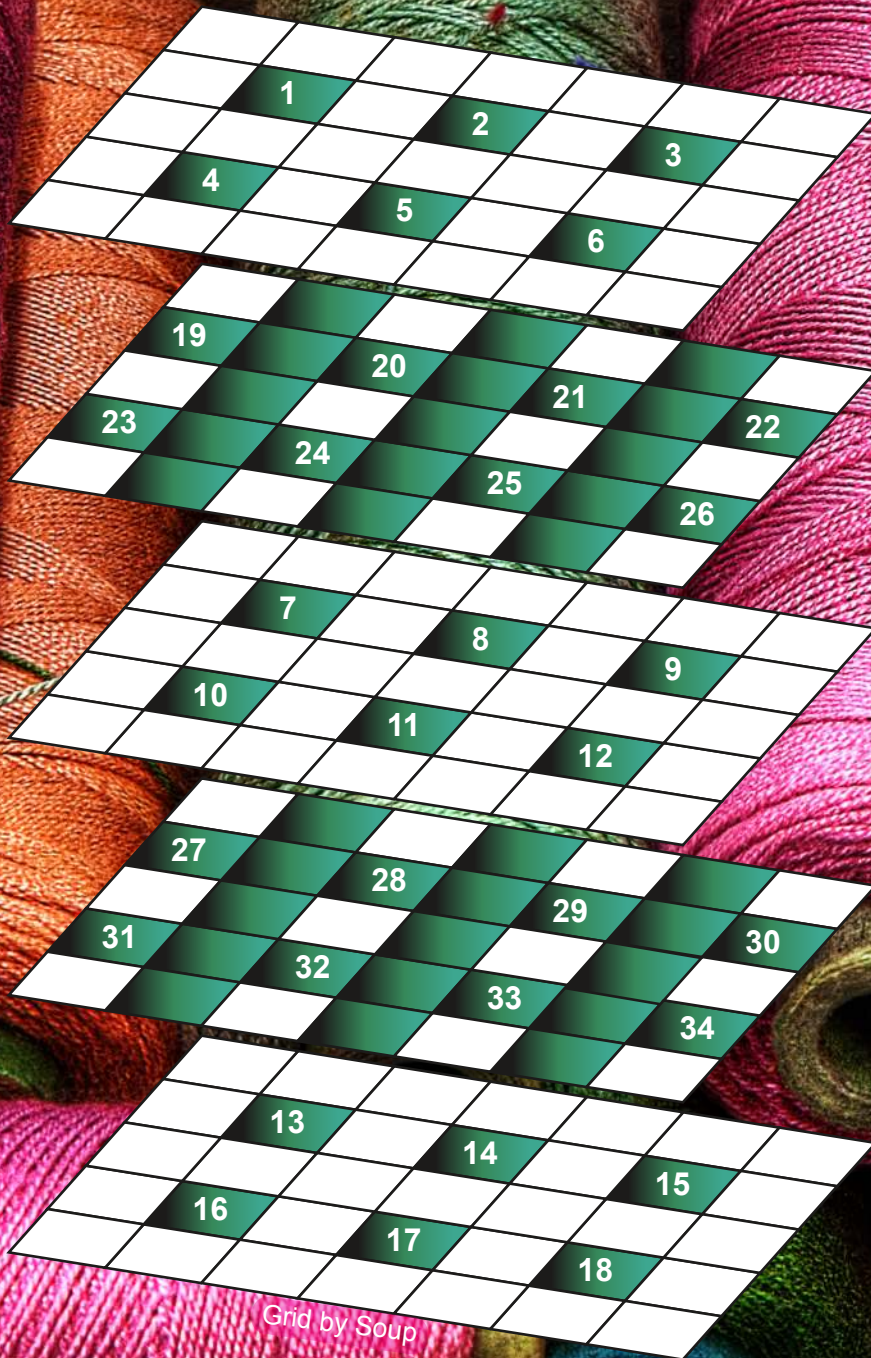
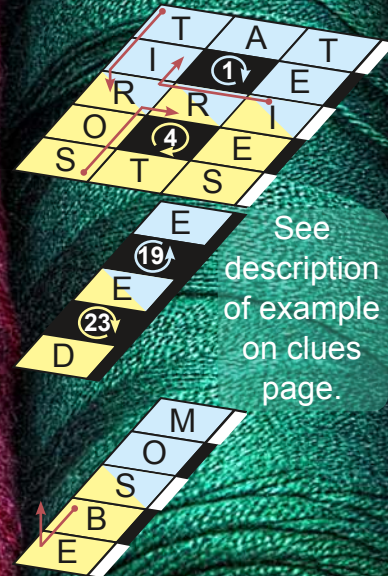

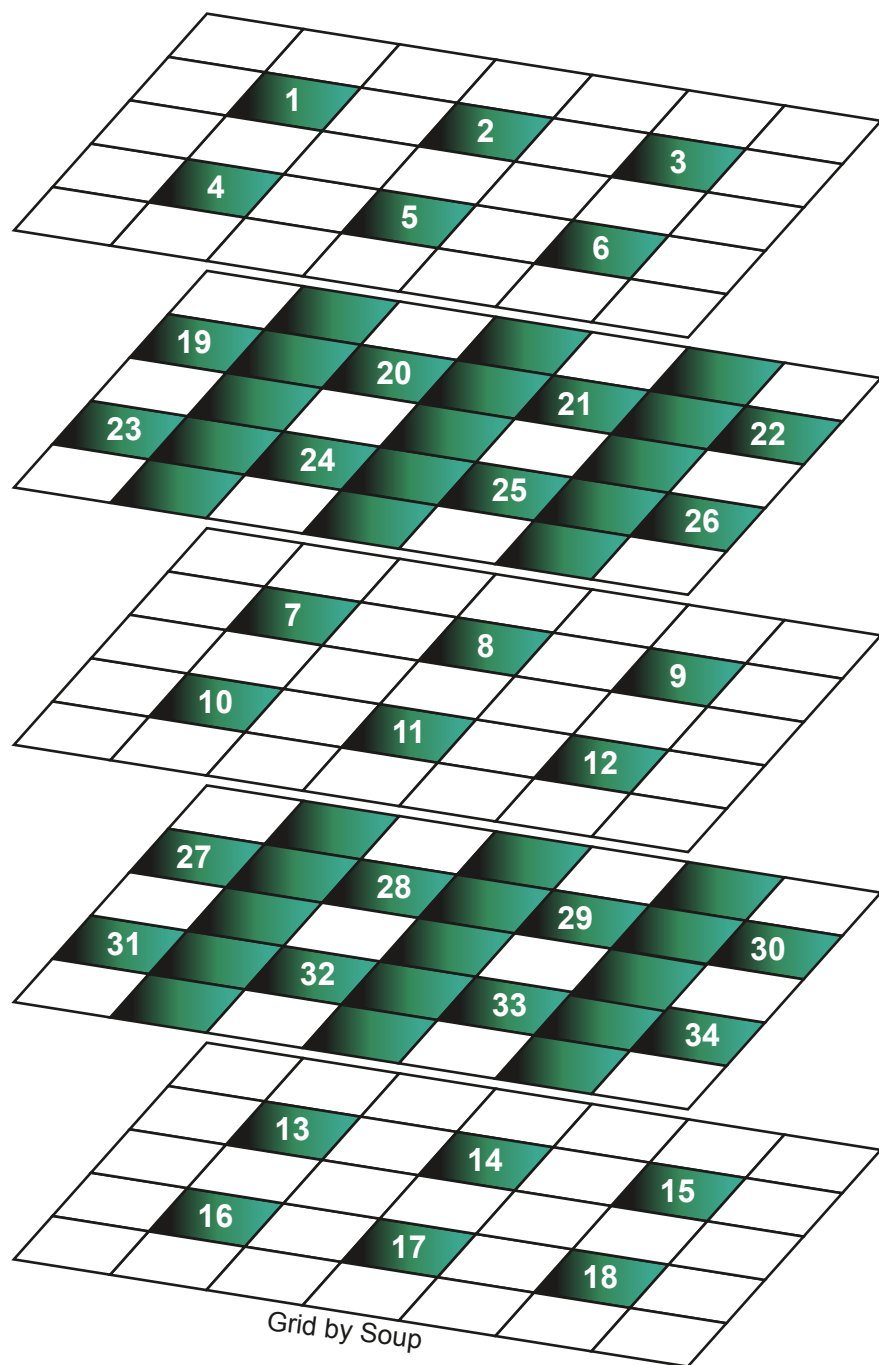


Every clue gives rise to an eight-letter solution. These should be entered in a ring around the clue's number (e.g. 25 for Day 1) in the grid. Solvers should determine where in the ring the solution starts, and which direction it should go in (clockwise or anticlockwise). Assuming vertical solutions are viewed from the right-hand side of the grid and horizontal solutions from the top down, 18 go clockwise and 16 go anticlockwise.

Clues are presented in alphabetical order of their solutions.
