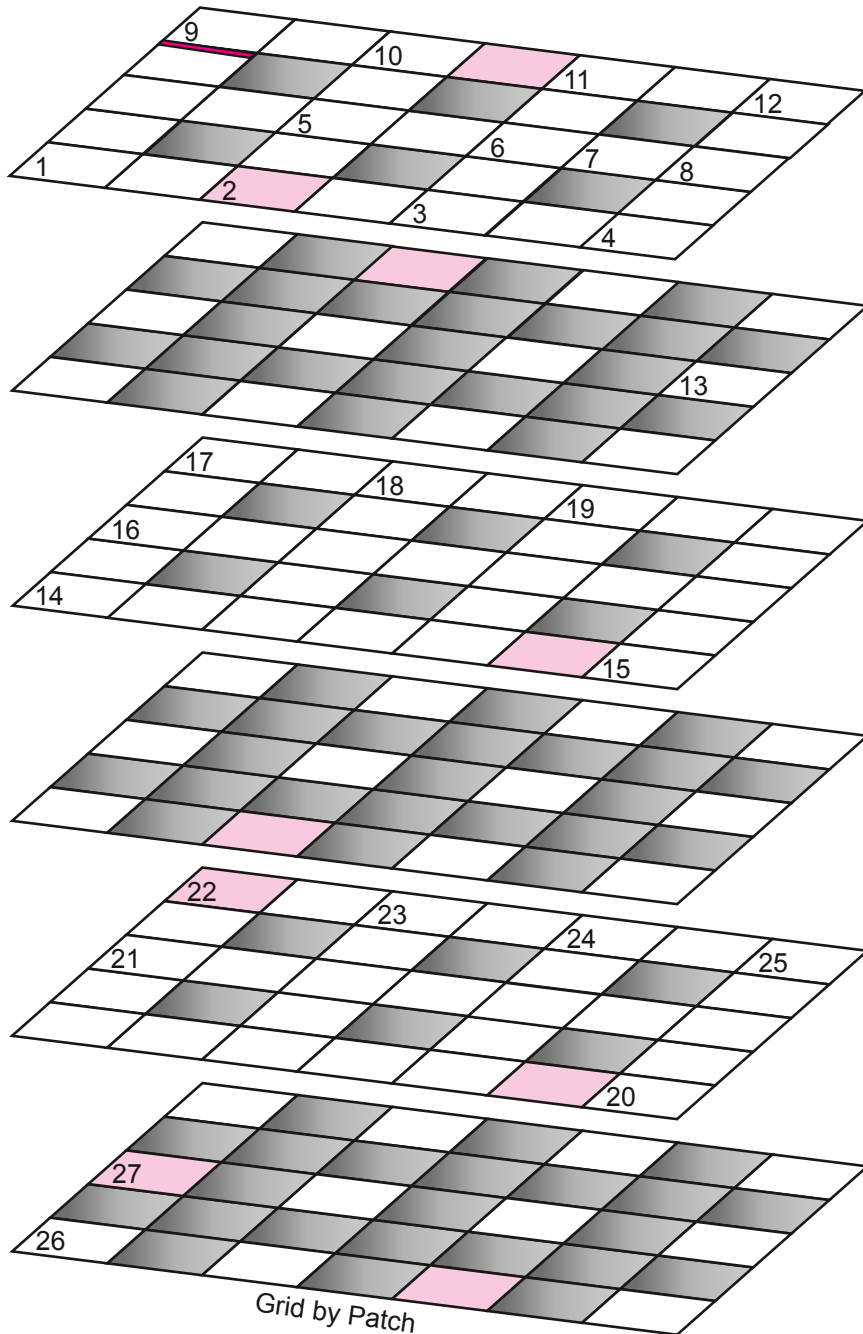
Grid by Patch

Eight clues have no definition; combining their answers along with a cryptic treatment of one other answer could make something delightfully thematic (6), which you must also include.

The answer to day 14 is not in dictionaries but is a phrase consisting of two very common words. Clues are numbered in alphabetical order of their solutions.
