

The puzzle celebrates the 200th anniversary of one widely recognised to be a world's best. This bicentenarian (4,6,6) is a native of 26ac (unclued). Each of the sets of shaded cells hints at one part of the bicentenarian's name: one more broadly than the others. Certain cells are part of two or even three sets. Strings of tinted cells – some unclued, some part of longer entries – singly or in combination refer to what a type of athlete does, a South Asian town, a pair of celebrities sometimes confused, a European royal family, a tourist attraction in the Vaucluse, an historical figure, a slang word from the field of lechery, and a short literary character.

Clues are numbered in alphabetical order of their solutions.
